Dear Parents/Carers

Following our recent inspection, please find attached our latest Ofsted report.

Despite the turbulence which the school has encountered over the last few years, we are pleased that the inspection team have recognised the impact the current leadership team have had in order to bring about improvements.

The quality of teaching and pupils' progress has been judged as good throughout Key Stage 1. The leadership team identified some areas to develop in Key Stage 2 and have been working well with teachers to improve teaching, learning and outcomes over recent months. However, we have not had enough time to show sufficient impact of these actions, hence the overall effectiveness for "Quality of Teaching, Learning and Assessment", "Outcomes for Pupils" and "Effective Leadership and Management" have been judged as requires improvement. This said, the report states teachers in year 6 have high expectations and provide appropriately challenging work that builds on their knowledge to ensure pupils' strong progress.

"Early Years Provision" has been judged as good and the report highlights that children make consistently good progress from their starting points across all areas of learning. Children's attention span is good; they pay close attention to well-planned and appropriately challenging activities; settle quickly into school life and feel safe.

"Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare" has been judged as good. We are proud of the behaviour our children; how they conduct themselves around school and their positive attitude to learning. We are also proud of the positive impact school has on the personal development and welfare of our children.

Staff are incredibly positive; are working collaboratively and are determined to move the school forward, with the continued support of our parents.
