The time is fast approaching for our visit to Aylmerton, and we are all getting very excited. I would like to share with you the Kit List for the week so that you can begin to gather the clothes and equipment your child will need.

They need everything on the Kit List. I would like to emphasise the need for at least two pairs of sensible shoes. Trainers are ok if they are waterproof as there are times when we walk through wet grass or mud. Canvas trainers such as Converse style shoes will get wet and we are not able to dry them.

Slippers are important, as we are not allowed to wear our muddy shoes in the centre.

The Kit List suggests 4 tops for layering and at least 2 jumpers. This might sound a lot, but when we are walking during the evening, it does get very, very cold. Aylmerton staff insists that the children wear 6 layers for the evening walks, and we really do need them. I am even taking my scarf, gloves and hat this year!
